



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Unveiling a Literary Masterpiece:

"Book Launch on Climate Change SDG goal-4.7"

The School of Education Humanities hosted a book launch and discourse centered on the international publication, "Young People and Climate Change Communication and Responses," on September 25, 2023, at Manav Rachna University in Faridabad. The event featured a panel discussion moderated by Ms. Alka Tomar, Chairperson of the Centre for Youth (C4Y) and President of the Centre for Environment Communication (CEC) in New Delhi, Co-author and Editor Prof. Matthew Hibberd (Professor of Media Management, Media Economics, and Media and Cultural Industries at Università Svizzera italiana (USI), Lugano, Switzerland,) who shared the book's objectives and contributions from co-authors across India, Bangladesh, Italy, and Switzerland.

The panel discussion focused on climate change communication and responses, particularly among young people. Prof. Hibberd emphasized the crucial role of youth in addressing the climate crisis, while Prof. Rashee Singh, HOD, Department of Education and Humanities outlined strategies to prepare students, future educators, for action on Sustainable Development Goals, especially SGD4.7. The discussion concluded on the importance of global thinking and local action, highlighting youth's potential in implementing SDGs.
