Q3 B In Company A, a family enterprise, the founder was the sole owner. One day, he was killed in an airplane accident. His two sons were not in the business. Fortunately, there was a board of directors, which was to prove to be crucial in ensuring the survival of the company. Nonexecutive board members helped manage the diffi cult succession. External help was necessary, because each son received 50% of the shares and both had ambitions to become the next CEO and difficent interests at the beginning. The external board members helped to establish an executive team comprising the two brothers. The nonexecutive board members are of considerable assistance in this company, especially in the case of conflicts, for example, when the two brothers cannot agree on a decision. The main roles of the nonexecutive board members are to listen, mediate, and advise the two brothers. Monitoring them is a minor role, since the two managing directors are also the owners, who have the ultimate decision-making authority and could even fire the nonexecutive board members if they both agree.

- a. Do you think a focused family enterprise with one owner needs a different type of board than a family enterprise that owns different companies and where the management team consists only of nonfamily? Give reasons as to why we need to establish a board of directors.
- b. Draw the family business governance system. Explain the different types of family business owners.

#### Q4.A. Read the case given below and answer the questions:

Rob and Janet—members of a small family consisting of twelve members— wanted to complete their estate planning and needed a business valuation to model their plan. They contacted their business's accountant to discuss the matter and obtain the relevant information. The accountant had previously spoken to the family council chair, who directed that all communications between family shareholders and the accountant would need to be approved by the family council. The accountant informed Rob and Janet about the expectations and asked for permission to speak with the family council chair, Amber. They granted permission, and the accountant called Amber to discuss the matter. During the discussion, it became clear that Rob's and Janet's need was likely shared by other family members, and a more formal valuation would be needed to provide evidence that the valuation was accurate. Amber then spoke to Rob and Janet about the broader family's need, and they agreed to Amber's suggestion that they bring their company accountant in to discuss valuations and their impact on estate planning. Amber then secured the support of the family council and planned for the education session. When the meeting finally occurred the following month, it was discovered that senior generation members Mark and Mary Jo were also in need of updated information to evaluate their estate plans. It had been years since the family had visited the issue of estate planning, and changes in the business and the legal environment required an update.

- a. In the given situation how was effective communication established between the family members and the outside advisor? What role did the family council play?
- Explain the various ways by which the communication can be managed between the family and the board.
