Padma Shree Awardee Prof. Upendar Baxi discussed how Legislative Drafting is the least studied subject in India, despite it being the most important subject was of the view that mistakes in Legislative Drafting cannot be taken lightly. Due to a minor mistake, an offender can go Scott free, or an innocent can be put unnecessarily behind bars. He also explained the three principles of the 3 Prudence- Legis prudence, Jurisprudence, and Demos prudence. Prof Baxi further suggested for the laws to have a "Sunset Clause", where a law should get expired after a few years, or after it serves its purpose and had put emphasis upon the renewal of Laws by the Legislature and should be weeded out when they turn obsolete.

- Ms. Rashmi Arora explained the difference between data sharing and essential data sharing. Ms. Arora was also of the view that the major challenge is technology, and government institutions will take a lot of time to put technology in place.
- Mr. Malhotra was of the same view that law is not able to keep pace with the swiftly developing technology, not only in our country but in other countries as well. He then introduced Ms. Sunanda Tewari to the discussion, who apprised us of the concept of Data localisation and the conflict of interest with trade agreements. 
