

School of Law invited Dr Nathan Cooper for a Guest Lecture

The School of Law, in collaboration with the Office of International Affairs organised a guest lecture on 15th September 2023. The speaker for the event was Dr Nathan Cooper, Associate Professor at *Te Piringa - Faculty of Law*, University of Waikato, New Zealand. The topic for his session was “*Thoughts on the future of legal theory: Reimagining human rights, or the rights of reimagined humans?*”.

Being a specialist in Environmental Law and Human Rights jurisprudence, Dr Cooper addressed the growing concerns at the interplay of the two areas of law. He traced the growth of human rights law in the international framework, providing an inter-disciplinary approach that connected Environmental Law, Human Rights, and elements of Corporate Law.

Dr Cooper’s use of case laws and landmark judgements kept the students interested and engaged through the session. Students were inquisitive, and the prompt to-and-fro between the speaker and the audience made the session lively.
