

Agenda Item No. 2.4 - Overview of the Quality Initiatives Implemented by IQAC for the session July-Dec 2023

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) presented the following report detailing the systematic execution of quality enhancement procedures undertaken for the session July-Dec 2023.

The details for the various initiatives taken by the IQAC are given below:

- Academic Audits: Three Internal Academic Audits by IQAC & one External Academic audit by Prof. (Dr.) Sandeep Grover, Dean (Institutions) & Dean(Quality Assurance), Professor, Mechanical Engineering, J.C. Bose University of Science & Technology, YMCA Faridabad, Haryana.
- Energy Environment & Green Audit: The second cycle of Energy Environment & Green Audits were conducted successfully by EHS Alliance Pvt. Ltd. on 16th January 2024. The observations & recommendations have been recorded for further action & review. The reports are awaited.
- ISO Surveillance: ISO Surveillance was conducted successfully for ISO 9001:2015, ISO 14001:2015, ISO 50001:2018. Observations for improvement were shared.
- Monthly Information System: Monthly Report format as per NAAC requirements & benchmarks have been introduced and implemented for all Departments & Offices from December 2023 onwards. The data is collated, compiled and vetted by the IQAC working committee.
- Faculty Orientation Program: Comprehensive Faculty orientation program has been
 organized for newly appointed faculty members 5th August 2023 to 30th September, 2023 to
 equip them with awareness of the academic policies, teaching learning and evaluation
 methods etc.

The IQAC members recorded the activities and commended the dedication of the IQAC team to quality initiatives, urging them to persevere in their efforts.

Agenda Item No. 2.5 - Review of the Academic Audit report for the session July-Dec 2023.

The members were detailed about the execution process and outcomes of the Academic Audit conducted by IQAC. It was reported that the Academic Audit at the university consisted of a thorough three-phase internal audit carried out by internal academic auditors, followed by an external audit. The academic audit Review- I was conducted in August 2023 to gauge the academic preparedness of the faculty members and the departments. The ERP registrations, course plans, course assessment plans, course materials, and pedagogical approaches to be adopted by faculty members were reviewed. The second academic audit review conducted in October 2023, post-mid-semester, focused on monitoring continuous assessments implemented against the faculty-submitted Course Assessment Plans (CAPs), Attendance analysis, Feedback analysis, Mid-Term marks analysis, Action taken reports and other relevant data required in the academic audit form. The third academic audit review, conducted in January 2024 after the semester's completion, involved a thorough examination of complete course files, end semester marks analysis, and assessments of slow and fast learner progress, including action taken reports and impact analysis.

Further members were informed about the external audit scheduled on February 3, 2024, with Prof. (Dr.) Sandeep Grover, Dean of Institutions, J.C. Bose University of Science & Technology, YMCA, Faridabad, serving as the external auditor. The audit encompassed review of the academic audit forms followed by comprehensive review of files related to course files, CO-PO attainment data, different pedagogies, internal evaluation, experiential learning, industrial visits, industrial training, program booklets, departmental meeting records, MOOC, assignments, video lectures and lab stock. Recommendations and observations from the external audit were communicated to departments for integration into future semesters, ensuring ongoing improvement in academic processes and quality.

The members conveyed their appreciation for the IQAC's efforts and underscored the importance of conducting comprehensive academic audits to ensure compliance with standards and regulations, enhance the quality of education and research, promote transparency and accountability, and ultimately, contribute to the overall improvement of academic excellence and integrity.

Agenda Item No. 2.6 - Admission status report of AY 2023-24 and enrolment ratio

The admission data for both 2022-23 and 2023-24 was presented. It was submitted that in the academic year 2022-23 and 2023-24, a total of 968 and 1038 seats were sanctioned respectively under different programs. In which, a total of 756 and 808 students were admitted respectively under various programs offered by the University leading an enrolment percentage of 78 in both academic years (2022-23 and 2023-24).

Enrolment percentage for AY 2022-23 and 2023-24



Agenda Item No. 2.7- Quality Initiatives implemented at the university level concerning Teaching, Learning, and Evaluation during the session July-Dec 2023

The members were informed about the implementation of variety of pedagogical approaches and integration of technology in teaching learning process across the University. Dean Academics emphasised that through techniques like project-based learning, cooperative and active learning, flipped classrooms, experiential learning, case-based teaching and peer-to-peer learning, an enhancement of the overall educational experience was aimed and witnessed. The approaches not only adopted a comprehensive understanding of the course but also promised significant outcomes like students' preparation with both theoretical knowledge and practical skills relevant to their respective fields, exposure to real-world situations, development of critical thinking skills and improved decision making capacity

A summary of the activities along with a detailed report is annexed as Annexure 2.7.



The efforts of the faculty members in deploying innovative ideas were acknowledged by the IQAC members. It was suggested that feedback for PBL courses be obtained separately, as well as for topics employing different pedagogical approaches. Emphasis was placed on displaying information regarding pedagogies on the website, including a list of problems and projects used in PBL along with their outcomes. Additionally, consideration was given to the inclusion of LinkedIn Learning Courses in interactive pedagogies.




Agenda Item No. 2.8 - Report on the Course Outcomes (CO) assessment process in accordance with Bloom's Taxonomy

Dean Academics apprised the members about the course outcome assessment process implemented within the University, aimed at enhancing overall quality of the educational experience. The following key points were highlighted:

- a) Drafting of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) Manual: Departments have drafted an OBE manual, incorporating a consolidated report mapping both course and program outcomes for the entire 2023 pass-out batch. Sample reports from both direct and indirect assessments through the ERP system were presented.
- b) Review and Update of Departmental Course Outcomes: The office of Dean Academics reviewed and updated departmental course outcomes for the session Jan-June 2024. Specific initiatives were undertaken including Creating comprehensive Course Outcome statements, Integrating Bloom's Taxonomy action verbs into formulation for enriched learning objectives, Designing separate Course Outcomes for theory and lab courses, Aligning Course Outcomes and Program Outcomes at the highest level (3) for comprehensive connection.
- c) Workshops and Training conducted: IQAC, in collaboration with the Dean Academics Office, organized workshops including the "Fundamentals of Designing Course Outcome" and "CO-PO Attainment Calculations" to equip faculty members with CO-PO mapping and attainment.
- d) Study of Phase-wise Attainment for July-Dec 2023: Differentiated actions were taken based on students' levels of understanding. For students with low understanding: Question banks, additional assignments, and extra classes were provided. For quick learners: Emphasis on project work, opportunities for publishing papers, and encouragement for certification courses. A comprehensive impact analysis was conducted, paving the way for necessary actions to be implemented in preparation for upcoming batches.

The IQAC members acknowledged the Dean Academics office for the robust Course Outcome assessment process. It was suggested to implement the necessary actions identified through the impact analysis and continuously monitor the CO assessment process for the on-going improvement.

Agenda Item No. 2.9 - Report of the Value-Added Courses offered for the holistic development of the students during the session July-Dec 2023

The IQAC members were apprised about the opportunities offered to the students with a focus on enhancing specific skills and knowledge beyond the regular curriculum with the goal of fostering interdisciplinary engagement through Value added courses. In this regard, a central registration link was introduced during the odd semester for VAC enrolment. The initiative aimed to encourage students from various departments to participate in value-added courses extending beyond their core disciplines. It was informed that the courses such as Introduction to Electric Vehicle, Understanding of Data Science using Python, and First-time Managers had a mixed audience. It was further notified that in the current semester, students specializing in computer science and technology have chosen courses from the Law department, showcasing a cross-disciplinary interest.

The Summary of Value Added Courses offered in the Odd semester for the Academic session 2023-24 is presented below and annexed as **Annexure 2.9.**

The IQAC members suggested to hold VAC presentations akin to elective presentations from next academic year, followed by registration through the ERP system so as to result in a significant increase in interdisciplinary enrolment rates.

Agenda Item No. 2.10 - Report of Mentoring system for the session July-Dec 2023.

In the academic session July-Dec 2023, 115 faculty members were assigned the responsibility of mentorship. Each mentor was allotted a maximum 20 mentees. The mentors conducted the meetings as per the schedule in the class time table, identified the academic, social and personal needs/ issues of the mentees and took necessary actions to resolve the same.

A comprehensive report of the minutes of Mentor - Mentee meetings and Action taken is annexed as **Annexure 2.10.**

The members recognized the dedication of the mentors, and the esteemed Pro-VC, MRU requested prompt action on medical or special attendance cases to ensure that the list of students facing detention can be formulated immediately after the semester concludes, without any delay.

Opening remarks by the Chairman

Hon'ble VC Sir Prof. (Dr.) I.K. Bhat extended a warm welcome to all the members and shared the objective of IQAC during his opening address. He stressed the importance of organizing review and brainstorming sessions that engage the entire faculty as a unified effort essential to monitor the progress in preparation for the accreditation assessments. Hon'ble VC Sir further highlighted the significance of integrating environmental and sustainability initiatives into the academic framework. He pointed out the need of implementing additional measures to elevate and encourage research activities within the institution. This aligns with the objectives outlined in the National Education Policy (NEP) and the National Credit Framework, which emphasize the importance of motivating and actively involving students in research work.

Agenda Item No. 1 - Status Update on the ongoing Accreditation Process

To update the current status of the ongoing accreditation process by NAAC and NBA.

The IQAC members were briefed on the progress of the ongoing accreditations, specifically with NAAC & NBA. It was informed that the university submitted it's institutional information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) application form on 20th January 2023 followed by successful submission of Self Study Report (SSR) on 5th April 2023. As a part of DVV process, the university responded to 26 queries on 7th May 2023 and is waiting for the final communication regarding DVV and PTV.

Further, it was shared that the Department of Computer Science & Technology has applied for NBA accreditation. Following the initial registration on January 16, 2023, the pre-qualifier submission followed on 19th January 2023. A significant milestone was reached on 30th March 2023, with the submission of the comprehensive Self-Assessment Report (SAR). The dates that have been proposed for the visit are 29th Sept to 1th October 2023.




Courses Focused on Employability, Entrepreneurship, and Skill Enhancement

Integration of Technology & Experiential Learning Methods

Dean Academics explained the effect of Integration of new pedagogies and practical learning across academic fields in providing quality education. It was shared that the Engineering programs encourage hands-on problem-solving by allowing students to develop mini-projects and test prototypes, bridging the gap between theory and practical approaches. Students in the Department of Management and Commerce are acquainted with real-world business simulations and case studies, where they can practice leadership and decision-making skills. Moot court exercises, mock trials and internships in the Law programs provide an opportunity to apply legal theory to actual issues, enhancing advocacy and bargaining skills. Inquiry-based learning, in which students do experiments and inquiries to increase their understanding of scientific concepts, benefits the students of the department of Sciences. Aspiring teachers in Education study interactive tactics to ensure they can effectively engage and inspire pupils in real classrooms. These integrations ensure that students acquire not just academic information but also practical skills and expertise. A list of such technology integration techniques and experiential learning tools adopted in various courses across all the programs is provided as Annexure-2.3.

The IQAC members acknowledged the importance of this initiative and recognized the necessity to provide training for all faculty members to enable them to embrace and excel in innovative pedagogies especially use of IT tools and PBL. Furthermore, they emphasized the need to monitor the innovative pedagogy employed by the departments, ensuring alignment with the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

Decision: The IQAC noted the suggestion for future compliance.

Analysis of Feedback and Action Taken Based on Feedback

The feedback for the AY 2022-23 from different stakeholders including students, faculty members, alumni and employers was conducted on curriculum design and development with an aim to strengthen and improve the academic system at Manav Rachna University. Agenda Item No. 3 - Research & Innovation Activities

To present and share the research & innovation activities report for the AY 2022-23 including:

Summary of Faculty and Student Publications, both in Journals and Conferences

Dean Research shared the significant contributions of the faculty members & the students to the academic and research community with a total of 144 research papers publications. [Annexure-3.1]. The papers have been featured in reputed journals (110), conferences (34), books, and book chapters (41) that are listed in Scopus, Web of Science, and other platforms.

Furthermore, the students have collectively published 13 research papers in journals and an additional 09 papers in conferences.

According to the latest data from the Scopus database, the total number of research publications attributed to our university has increased to an impressive 607, up from the previous count of 583. Furthermore, our university's h index, a measure of research impact and productivity, has also seen growth, now standing at 35, compared to the previous value of 33 [Annexure-3.1].

Update on Patents Filed, Published, and Granted

In the AY 2022-23, 02 new provisional patent applications have been filed by the faculty members, a total of 62 patent applications got published and 03 patent applications have been granted and 04 patent application got registration of design representing a wide spectrum of innovations and ideas generated within the community of faculty members and students [Annexure-3.2].

Technical and Research-oriented Events Organized for Faculty and Students

To facilitate culture of innovation, learning, and research, MRU organized a variety of technical and research-oriented events for both our esteemed faculty and students serving as platforms for knowledge exchange and skill enhancement. In the AY 2022-23, a total of 35 events have been organised related to Skill Development (21), Entrepreneurship (08), Intellectual Property Rights (02), and Research Methodology (04). The list of events related to Skill Development, Entrepreneurship, Intellectual Property Rights, and Research Methodology in the Academic Year 2022-23 is attached as [Annexure-3.3].

Recognition Received for Outstanding Research Endeavours by Faculty and Students

Dean Research shared noteworthy recognitions for the outstanding research endeavours undertaken by both the dedicated faculty and talented students. The institution has achieved a remarkable total of 51 research recognitions for students and impressive 25 research recognitions for our esteemed faculty members [Annexure-3.4].

The IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) members expressed their appreciation for the university's research endeavours. However, they stressed the crucial need for implementing additional measures to elevate and encourage research activities within the institution. The Department of Student Welfare (DSW) has consistently organized cultural and sports events that have positively impacted the student community. These events have not only enriched the academic journey but also promoted cultural appreciation, artistic expression, and talent development among students. Nearly 48 cultural and sports events were organised by the DSW that span across various artistic domains, including dance, music, and poetry [Annexure-4.1].

Student Achievements in Cultural Activities

In the AY 2022-23, our students participated in a wide range of cultural and sports activities on interuniversity platforms and won 12 awards. Their accomplishments are summarized in the Annexure-4.2.

The IQAC members duly acknowledged the information and stressed the importance of increasing sports initiatives in alignment with the Khelo India program. They also emphasized the need for student activities with a stronger focus on cultural, sports, research, and placement-related activities.

Decision: To implement a fortnightly student activities report to ensure consistent and effective monitoring of these initiatives.

Agenda Item No. 5 - Student Progression

To present the status of student placement and progression to higher studies for the AY 2022-23

The placement coordinator shared an overview of the status of student placement and their progression to higher studies for the AY 2022-23. A total of 198 students out of 428 (46.2%) have successfully secured employment opportunities in various reputed companies and organizations. Eight students have opted for higher studies. The Environment, Energy and Green Audit conducted

MRU has been assessed by EHS Alliance Services for the comprehensive study focussed on evaluating environmental impacts of institutional working framework to fulfil the requirement of Environment Audit, Energy Audit & Green Audit. The environment, energy and green initiatives undertaken by the University have been found satisfactory. The observations/recommendations by the Audit Team were shared. We commit to taking proactive measures to address these recommendations and continue our journey towards a greener and more sustainable future [Annexure 9.1].

Some of the recommendations include the following:

Environment Audit: Eco-friendly measures for purchase of articles, car-pooling practices to minimise air pollution; Environmental Monitoring, i.e. Stack Monitoring of DG sets, Water monitoring conducted by State Pollution Control Committee approved laboratory; agreement with third party authorised vendors for different types of waste management, such as e-waste, BMW, Plastic waste, etc. and increase the capacity of solar PV.

Energy Audit: More LED lights replacing tube lights, regular maintenance schedule of equipment like geyser, water coolers, pumps, etc. The efficiency of DG Sets and AC were found to be satisfactory during the audit trials as per the report. However, the recommendations include a regular maintenance of the equipment, insulation of AC's refrigerant lines in order to protect energy losses and purchase of BEE 5 Star rated equipment in future. It has been advised to use solar water heater instead of electric geysers. And electronics such as computers, printers, scanners, etc. more than 3 year or 5 years (as per their life) should be replaced with new computers/laptops.

Green Audit: Increase of solar panel capacity to meet at least 70% of electricity requirement, installation of solar heaters, consideration of environmental parameters in purchase policy.

For water conservation, it has been suggested to install water meters at every building for monitoring of water consumption per capita, adopt drip irrigation and sprinklers gardening to save water in campus, and maintain the flow rate of taps at not more than 2.5 litres/minute.

For community, increase plantation drives in nearby areas to balance the carbon emission and absorption, arrange training programs on environmental management system and nature conservation, involve lower hierarchy staff in environmental awareness programs and campaigns and enhance recycling.

It has been further advised to display messages at various locations to create awareness about Energy Savings Green building guidelines.

It is to share the successful attainment of ISO certifications for Manay Rachna University with respect to Quality Management System, Environmental Management System, and Energy Management System.

The ISO certifications achieved by Manav Rachna University signify the following:

The Quality Management System of MRU is ISO 9001:2015 certified w.e.f. from Dec 26, 2022 (valid till December 25, 2023).

The Energy Management System has attained ISO 50001:2018 certification w.e.f. from Dec 26, 2022 (valid till December 25, 2023).

The Environmental Management System of MRU is now ISO 14001:2015 certified w.e.f. from Dec 26, 2022 (valid till December 25, 2023).

Decision: The IQAC members took a note of the same and advised the coordinators to prepare for the next cycle due this year.

Agenda Item No. 10 - Academic Audit Proforma


To present the Academic Audit Proforma designed for the departments for the AY 2023-24.
