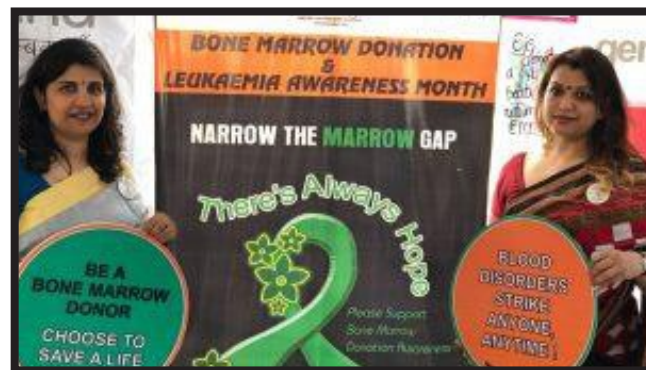
Village Visit to Anangpur (19.07.2018)

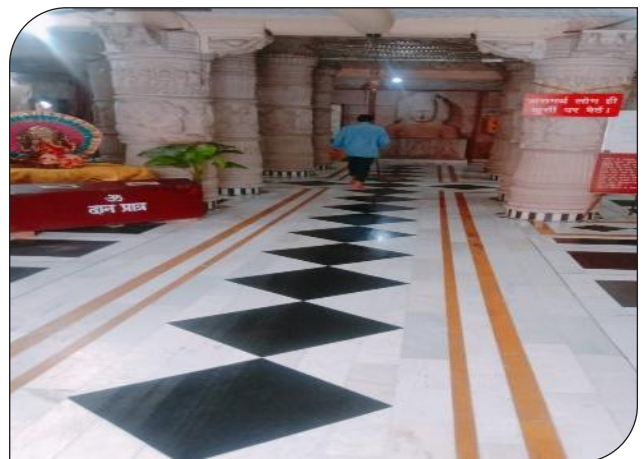

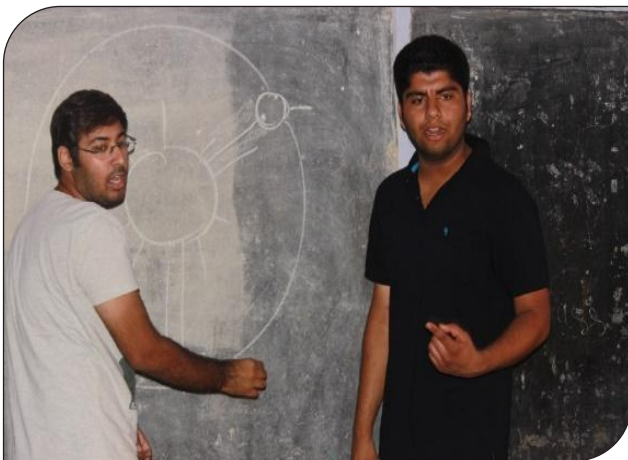
