THE GREAT RESIGNATION

Employee Engagement as a powerful tool to bring Great Retention



Anthony Klotz, a professor of business administration at Texas A&M University, coined the term in May 2021, attributing the phenomenon to pent-up demand from workers who deferred decisions to quit early in the pandemic.

The Great Resignation describes the elevated rate at which U.S.A & Globally workers resigned from their jobs starting in the spring of 2021, amid strong labour demand and low unemployment even as vaccinations eased the severity of the COVID-19 pandemic.

During the past year, companies struggled to comply with the ever-increasing Covid-19 restrictions. Even fully staffed companies had fewer employees available to work due to quarantines, illness, lack of childcare, or having to help their children home-school. Organizations that worked with the public had even more pressure to maintain sales and create new avenues of revenue that were compliant with restrictions to make up for lost sales.

The primary cause of the Great Resignation is likely intense competition for workers, as reflected in a high number of job vacancies and a lower unemployment rate.

Labour shortages are a global issue, with 41% of the world's workforce is likely to consider leaving their job and an even higher percentage for Gen Z (bom 1996-2012) at 54% (Microsoft, 2021). Currently, 45% of U.S. workers are actively or considering looking for a new job, and 15% say they have already switched to a new employer during the pandemic (News Content | Prudential, 2021).

The top reasons for leaving are better compensation/benefits, lack of growth opportunities within the current company, wanting to work remotely part-time or more, and doing something different. 25% of Millennials/Gen Y (born 1981-1985) want to work remotely part-time (News Content | Prudential, 2021). They also want growth opportunities to cover high educational debt and higher living costs in many urban settings (Harris et al., 2020).

EMPLOYEE ENGAGEMENT AS A POWERFUL TOOL TO BRING GREAT RETENTION:



Having employees who are thoroughly motivated and truly engaged with what they are doing is the most powerful weapon to hold employees in the organisation, and brings in competitive edge to the organisation in terms of productivity, efficiency and profitability.

- 5. Organising fun and other learning activities like family day, outdoor trip, Learning Boot Camp, Festival celebrations, Birthday celebrations etc.
- 6. Introducing good Reward & Recognition Police to recognise the contribution & achievements of employees to make the feel happy and motivated.

ONLINE INDUSTRY VISIT (PHARMACEUTICAL MANUFACTURING COMPANY)

On March 10, 2013, the School of Management and Commerce at Manav Rachna University organized a virtual industry tour for BBA HCM students in their 2nd, 4th, and 6th semesters. The tour was conducted online and focused on a pharma manufacturing facility.



The participating companies were Pharmasset Formulation Ltd. and Akums Pharma. The objective of the tour was to familiarize the students with the technological processes involved in pharmaceutical manufacturing.

Mr. M K Kaul, an Associate Professor from the School of Manav Rachna University, acted as the coordinator and presented a video showcasing the operations of M/S Pharma Synth Formulations Ltd. and Akums Pharma to a group of 30 students.

During the tour, the students were introduced to the manufacturing technology used for various product categories, including tablets, capsules, injectables, liquids, liquid/orals, ointments, powders, and sachets. The process of capsule manufacturing was specifically highlighted, starting from raw material procurement, storage, and testing to packaging, inspection, and filling. Safety management protocols and standard operating procedures (SOPs) were also demonstrated. The branding of raw materials was another interesting aspect discussed.

The tour aimed to emphasize to the students that technology is not only utilized in the manufacturing, storage, and marketing of finished pharmaceutical products but also in the production of individual units, even considering cost-effectiveness.

Additionally, a video was presented on Hospital-Acquired Infections (HAI) and cross-contamination, further enhancing the students' understanding in this area.
