1-8TH JANUARY 2024



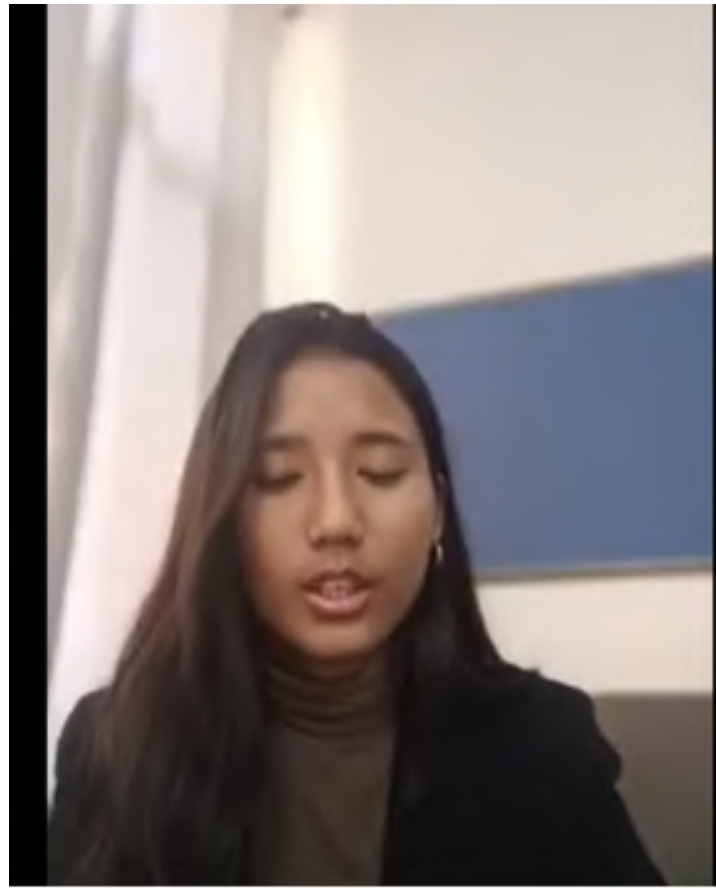
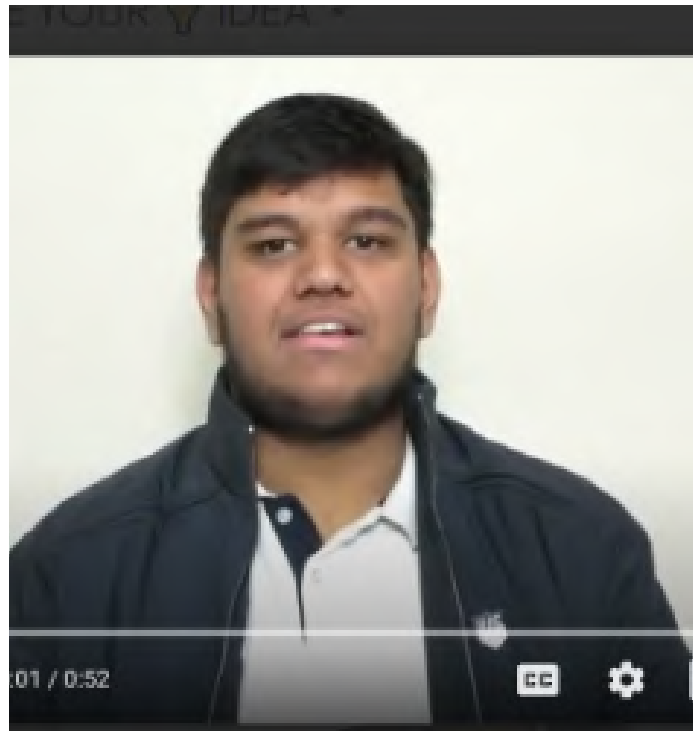
