

The Pitchdeck event was held on 24th August, 2023 at the K block room no. KG02. The event spanned from 1:50pm to 3:30pm, offering a mix of idea pitching, jury evaluation, and networking opportunities. The Jury consisted of an external guest Mr. Mohit Mahajan, NPDTT, Dr. Pradeep Kumar Varshney, Dean Research, MRU, Dr. Yogita Sharma, Head Innovation, Start-up and Entrepreneurship, MRU and Dr. J.P.Sharma, Associate Professor. ME.

There were total of 10 teams that were selected to present their idea and the jury evaluated them on the basis of novelty of idea, relation to sustainable goal, uniqueness and presentation.

With the opening of ceremony, each participating team took the stage to deliver a compelling pitch of their business idea. Teams were allotted a maximum of 5 minutes for their presentation, followed by a brief Q&A session with the jury. The Pitchdeck event's registration process and overall execution highlighted the dedication of the Innovation & Entrepreneurship Club to fostering a culture of innovation within the university. Mr. Shakeel Ahmed Khan clarified the visit's goals and purpose, highlighting the critical role that NSIC plays in India's economic environment. He went into further detail about how NSIC foster self-



sufficiency, innovation, and job prospects. He gave a thorough rundown of the several government initiatives designed to assist aspiring business owners in the MSME sector during this session. He also described how these programmes encourage young people to start their own enterprises by providing small firms with marketing possibilities, technical help, and financial aid. that was funded by the Indian government. This course gives prospective company owners the information and abilities they need to successfully navigate the financial side of entrepreneurship and get funding for their ventures.
