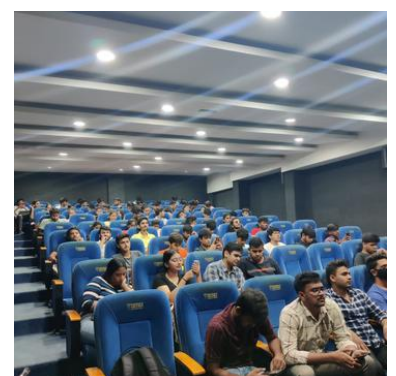

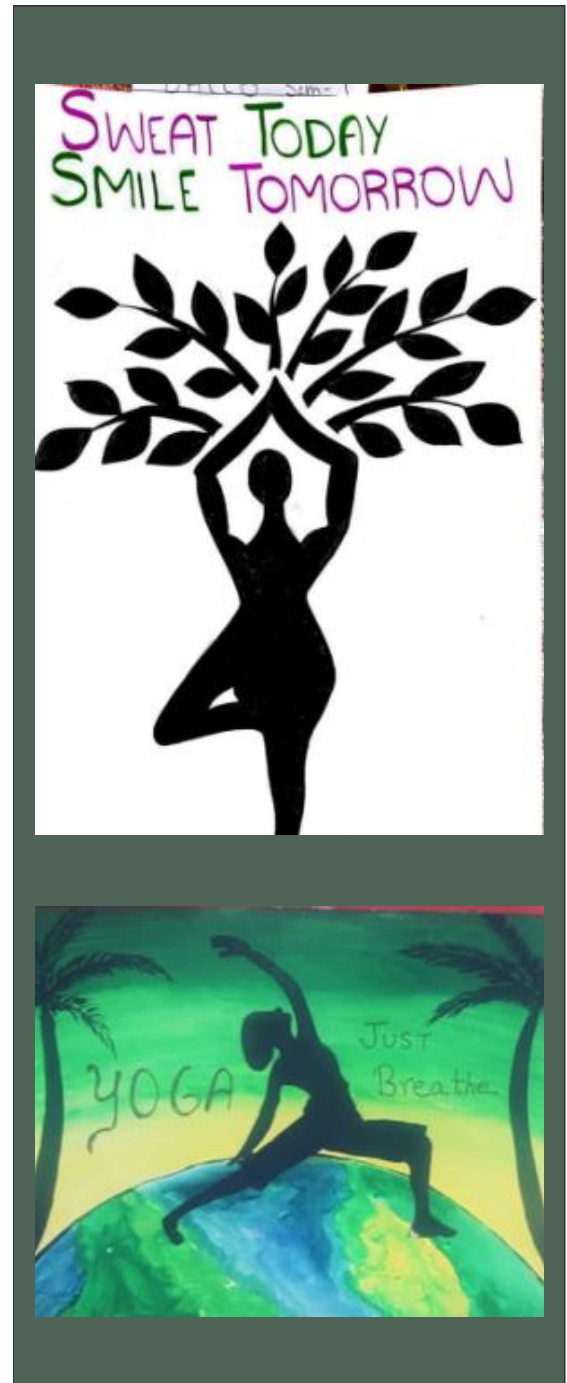


Poster-Making Competition
