





# NORMS AND CULTURE


### NEW TREND OF ERA: FOREIGN LANGUAGE




#### KNOWING YOUR DEPARTMENT




#### ALUMNI INTERACTION


#### NAVIGATING EMS AND SCHEDULES

#### **MINDFULNESS**




FINANCIAL FOOTPRINTS: WALKING THE PATH OF EVERYDAY LITERACY


### FUN WITH CHEMISTRY






