Manav Rachna University (MRU) ensures that local stakeholders, including local residents, government officials, and civil society representatives, have meaningful participation in university decision-making processes through their involvement in the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) and various Excellence Centre.

The IQAC is a pivotal body within the university's governance structure, focusing on maintaining and enhancing the quality of education and services offered. The mechanism for stakeholder participation is structured as follows:

Inclusive Membership: The IQAC includes representatives from various local stakeholder groups. This diverse membership allows for a broad range of perspectives and insights into university operations and strategic planning.

Regular Meetings: The IQAC conducts regular meetings where stakeholders can present their views, concerns, and suggestions regarding university initiatives and policies. This open forum encourages dialogue and the exchange of ideas.

Feedback Mechanism: MRU implements systematic feedback mechanisms that allow stakeholders to express their opinions on university practices, programs, and community engagement efforts. This feedback is critical for informing decision-making and improving university activities.

Collaboration on Community Projects: The university collaborates with local stakeholders on community-oriented projects and initiatives. Such collaborations ensure that the needs and priorities of the local community are considered in university planning.

MRU further enhances the engagement of local stakeholders by ensuring their representation across various centers and committees within the university structure. This representation is vital for incorporating community perspectives into university governance and decision-making. Centre like CLSR, CADR have local stakeholders in their advisory committees. Local stakeholders are included in advisory committees associated with academic and research centers. This inclusion allows them to provide input on curriculum development, research initiatives, and community-oriented programs.

And MRU **conducts yearly feedback** where stakeholders in the form of parents, industry and alumni come together and share their feedback on current challenges and opportunities. This exercise allows for collective brainstorming and fosters a sense of community ownership in university initiatives and based on their feedback, faculties take the action on it.

Through these mechanisms, MRU ensures that local stakeholders are not only consulted but actively participate in the decision-making processes. This approach not only enhances the quality of education but also strengthens the relationship between the university and the community it serves, fostering a collaborative environment focused on shared goals and mutual benefits.
