Economy class tickets are to be booked either directly from Air India or Government of India’s authorized travel agent only. In case of exigency only, where Air India flight is not available as per the date /time of the meeting, the same may be informed to AICTE for seeking prior approval of the Competent Authority. Tickets of private airlines, if required to be booked, may be booked directly from the airline counter/website and NOT from any private travel agent / online travel booking sites viz Makemy trip, Yatra, Booking, TripAdvisor, Clear trip etc.
2. Please carry your Boarding Pass of travel to be attached in the TA claim form to be submitted to AICTE. Payment of TA/honorarium will be made through NEFT, therefore, bank details (A/c No, IFSC code etc.) may be carried along to be filled in the mandate form of AICTE, in case not provided earlier.
3. It is also requested that in case Local transport/taxi is required from Airport to AICTE and/or return, the same may kindly be hired on own and claimed in AICTE TA form, which will be reimbursed as per AICTE rules.
4. It is further requested that in case an accommodation is required, you may kindly forward the dates of booking as per the meeting date and the same will be made available in the AICTE guest house. The date and time of check-in and check-out may be clearly indicated.
