








17.4.4 - Does your university as a body measure the sustainability literacy of students?






3. Seven Sustainability Competencies Questionnaire: A structured questionnaire has been developed to assess students' sustainability competencies. These seven competencies likely include systems thinking, anticipatory, normative, strategic, collaboration, critical thinking, and self-awareness skills, as outlined in widely recognized sustainability education frameworks. The questionnaire helps gauge students' strengths and areas for growth in each competency, supporting a comprehensive understanding of their sustainability literacy.
