Moot Court Society

- Organizes moot court competitions at intra- and inter-university levels.
- Conducts legal drafting workshops and courtroom simulation exercises to build advocacy skills.

Legal Aid Cell

- A student-led initiative supervised by faculty to provide free legal assistance.
- Runs awareness campaigns promoting social justice and community engagement.
- Collaborates with the Haryana Legal Service Authority.

Juris Fiesta Cultural Club

- Promotes holistic student development via cultural events and talent competitions.
- Integrates legal studies with creative and performance arts.

Entrepreneurship Cell (E-Cell)

- Encourages innovation and entrepreneurial thinking among students.
- Provides idea-pitching platforms, mentorship, and startup incubation support with industry collaboration.

NGO Collaborations

- Engages with NGOs on women empowerment, child rights, and environmental sustainability.
- Facilitates student internships and practical field projects supporting social causes.
