

Neutral Platform to Discuss issues

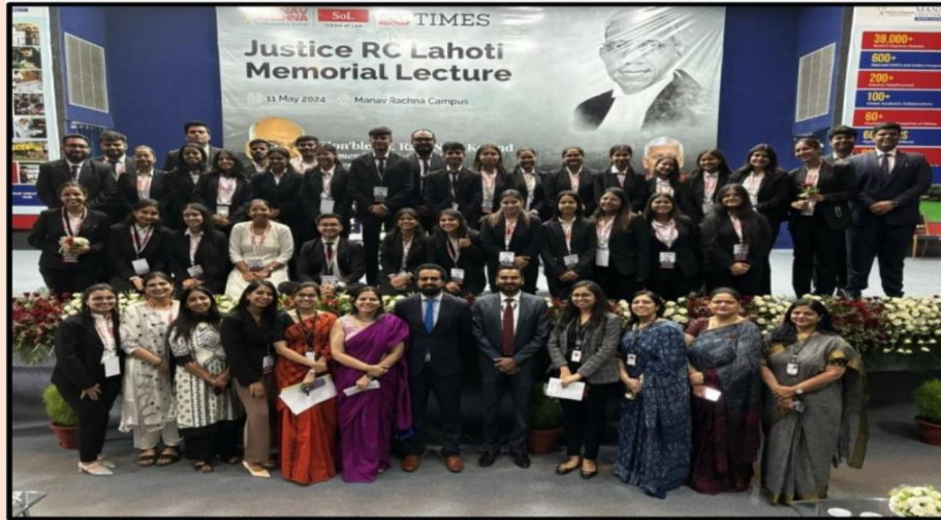
