The Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation, established on April 11, 2014, as a registered trust (section 12-A), is a philanthropic, multi-specialized, non-profit organization committed to the betterment of society. Acting as the Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) arm of Manav Rachna University, it serves as a nodal point for community development and welfare. The Foundation's vision is to foster inclusive growth, enhance the quality of life, and champion global causes related to cultural diversity, environmental conservation, and societal advancement.

Objectives and Key Initiatives

1. **Kaushal Karyashala:** Launched in 2018, this program equips students from government schools with employable skills, offering training in practical areas like Spoken English and Basic Computer Operations.
2. **Margdarshan:** Inaugurated in 2022, this initiative offers career counseling and psychometric assessments to students in government schools, aiding over 600 students with informed career choices.
3. **Books and Notebooks Donations:** Donated over *10,000 books* to foster educational access, especially in adopted villages and government schools.
4. **G2: Green Grah Initiative:** Aimed at reducing plastic waste, this initiative has recycled *1,000 kg* of plastic, producing park benches installed in public spaces.
5. **Mega Plantation Drives:** In collaboration with local institutions, this annual drive has planted over *40,000 trees* to combat deforestation and promote environmental sustainability.
6. **Give Her Wings to Fly:** This program addresses menstrual health and hygiene, distributing *50,000 sanitary napkins* and reaching out to *5,000 individuals*.
7. **Annual Blood Donation Camp:** Honoring Dr. O.P. Bhalla's legacy, this event has contributed over *10,300 blood units* to support healthcare needs.
8. **Ek Mutthi Daan - No One Sleeps Hungry:** Since 2014, this dry grains collection drive has donated approximately *117,000 kg* of food to those in need, in collaboration with NGOs.
9. **Health Camps:** Offering free health check-ups across several specialties, these camps focus on healthcare accessibility for underserved populations.

Target Audience: Students from Classes 10th to 12th in Government Schools

Objective

The **Margdarshan initiative**, led by **Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation** in collaboration with **Manav Rachna University**, addresses the crucial need for **structured career guidance** in government schools, where many students lack access to proper counseling. The primary objectives of this initiative include:

- **Empowering Students:** To provide students from **Classes 10th to 12th** with the necessary **career guidance** and information, helping them make **informed decisions** about their academic and career paths.
- **Bridging the Information Gap:** To offer **comprehensive psychometric assessments** and one-on-one sessions, allowing students to understand their **aptitudes, interests, and strengths**.
- **Supporting Families:** To help students' families gain clarity about **educational and professional opportunities**, enabling them to better support their children's aspirations.

Impact

Since its launch in **2022**, the **Margdarshan initiative** has had a meaningful impact on the lives of students in Faridabad and surrounding areas:

- **Direct Reach to Students:** The program began with over **150 students** in its inaugural year and expanded in **2023** to reach **300 students**. The initiative continued in **2023-2024**, involving students from schools like **GBSSS Old Faridabad**, **GGSSS Old Faridabad**, and others.
- **Personalized Career Guidance:** Students participated in **psychometric assessments** guided by **career counselors** from **Manav Rachna University**. These assessments provided them with insights into their **academic strengths** and **career prospects**, enabling **personalized guidance** tailored to their needs.
- **Campus Exposure:** Visits to the **Manav Rachna Campus** provided students with a **comprehensive overview** of available **courses and facilities**, allowing them to explore different fields of study. This exposure played a critical role in helping students visualize their future in higher education.

- **Community Engagement:** The program has built a sense of **community support** and **motivation**, encouraging students to **pursue their ambitions** and understand the **value of education** in transforming their futures.

Outcome

The **Margdarshan initiative** has yielded positive outcomes, making a significant difference in the educational landscape for students in government schools:

- **Empowered Decision-Making:** Students gained **clarity about their strengths** and career options, empowering them to choose **appropriate academic streams** and career paths based on their **interests and aptitudes**.
- **Increased Confidence:** The **one-on-one counseling sessions** and interactions with experienced counselors fostered **confidence** among students, allowing them to set **realistic goals** and **aspire to greater heights** in their education and careers.
- **100% Participation and Engagement:** The enthusiasm and active participation of students in each batch reflect the **program's effectiveness** in addressing their needs. With over **150 students** in the first year and more than **300 students** participating in subsequent years, the initiative has consistently **expanded its reach**.
- **Scholarships and Opportunities:** The program's commitment to **supporting students** has been further demonstrated through **scholarship opportunities**, as offered to the students of **Shirdi Sai Baba School, Faridabad**, on **13th June 2024**, providing financial assistance based on their academic performance.

Recent Events:

13th June 2024: 20 students from Shirdi Sai Baba School, Faridabad, received guidance and information on available courses and scholarships:

Under the *Margadarshan* initiative of the **Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation**, 20 students from **Shirdi Sai Baba School, Faridabad**, received personalized guidance. These students engaged in **one-on-one sessions** with the **Career Development Center (CDC)** team of **Manav Rachna University** after a **psychometric analysis** to better understand their interests, abilities, and aptitudes. The **admissions team** of Manav Rachna University further guided the students through various courses offered by both **Manav Rachna University** and **Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies**, helping them choose suitable academic paths and facilitating the **admissions process**. They were also assured of **scholarships** from the Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation based on their academic credentials. Additionally, a **comprehensive campus tour** was provided, showcasing available courses to assist them in making informed decisions for their future studies.

This initiative aimed to empower students in choosing a suitable career path while offering support through scholarships and detailed guidance.



4th May 2024: 40 students from NVN School, Bhiduki, participated in one-on-one sessions with the Career Development Center (CDC) team following psychometric analysis.

Under the *Margadarshan* initiative of the **Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation**, students receive personalized guidance based on their interests, abilities, and aptitudes. On **May 4, 2024**, a group of **40 students** from **NVN School, Village Bhiduki**, visited **Manav Rachna University** to participate in this program.

During their visit, the students engaged in **one-on-one sessions** with the **Career Development Center (CDC) team** of Manav Rachna University, following a **psychometric analysis** aimed at better understanding their individual strengths and career inclinations. The guidance sessions were tailored to help the students identify potential academic and career paths that align with their skills and interests.

In addition to the personalized guidance sessions, the students were provided with a **comprehensive campus tour**. The tour highlighted the various courses available at **Manav Rachna University** and **Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies**, enabling the students to make informed decisions about their future admissions and academic choices.

It is worth noting that **NVN School, Bhiduki** had previously supported the **Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation** during a **village visit** organized for **UK students**, demonstrating a strong community partnership.

This initiative reflects the commitment of Manav Rachna University and the Dr. O.P. Bhalla Foundation to empower students from diverse backgrounds, guiding them toward a successful academic journey and future career opportunities.



14th December 2023: 98 students from GGSSS Old Faridabad received career guidance at **Manav Rachna Campus**.

On **December 14th and 16th, 2023**, as part of the ongoing *Margadarshan* initiative, the **Dr. O.P. 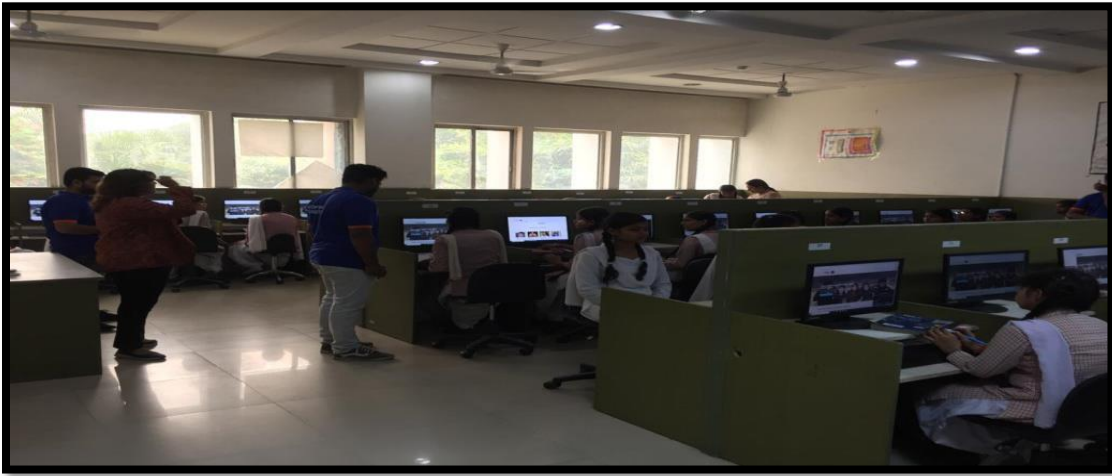
3rd November 2023: 56 students from GGSSS Old Faridabad attended the program.

2nd November 2023: 47 students from GGSSS Old Faridabad joined for career assessment.

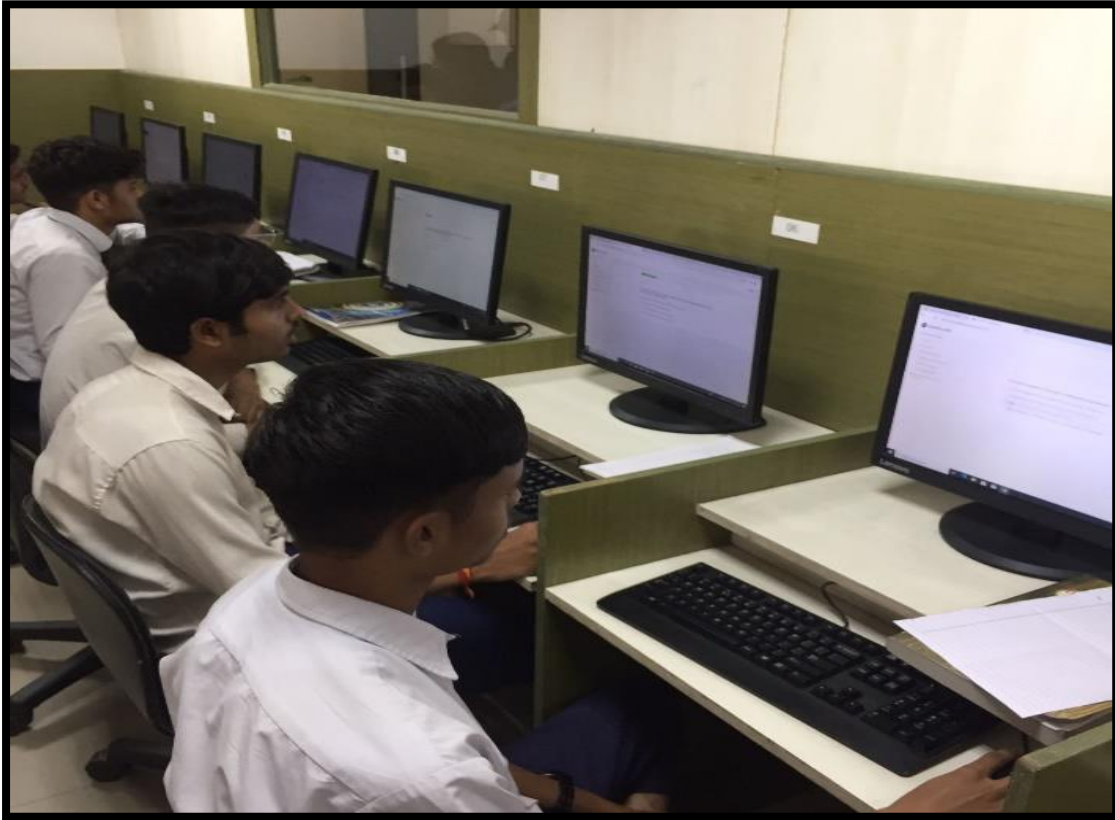

19th October 2023: 38 students from GBSSS Old Faridabad participated in the program.

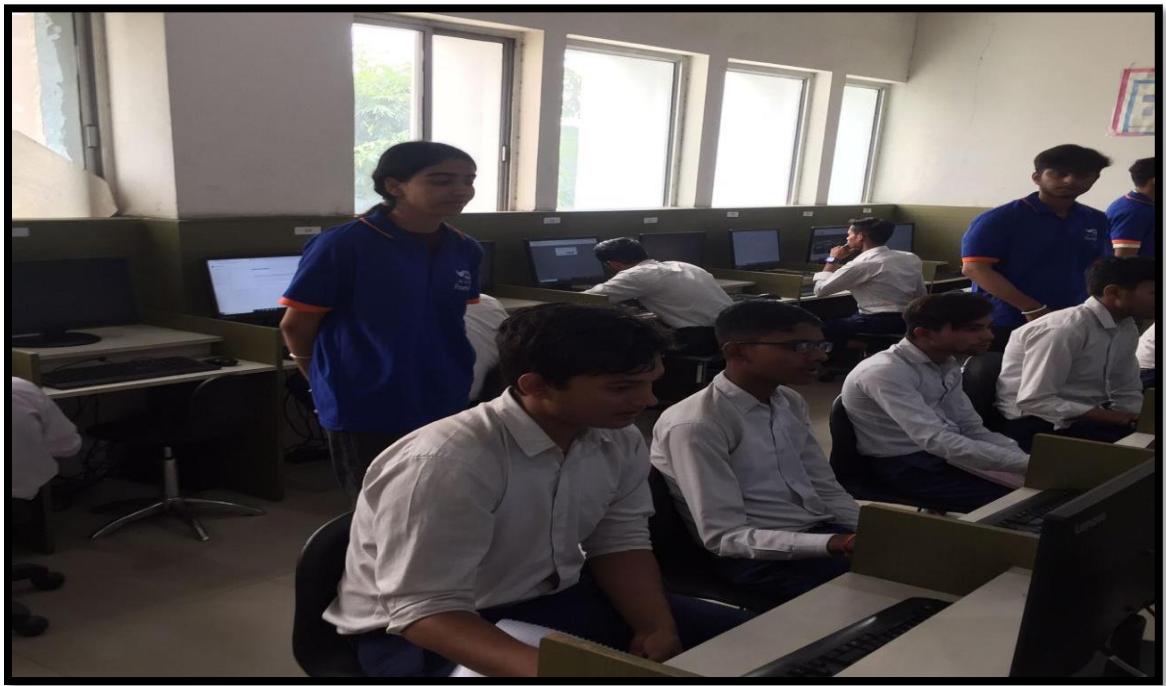

MEGA PLANTATION DRIVES

The Mega Plantation Drive is an annual initiative conducted by the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation in partnership with Manav Rachna Educational Institutions and the Manav Rachna Center for Peace and Sustainability. This drive aims to distribute and plant a diverse range of plants and trees in rural areas, government schools, and local community parks, thereby contributing to environmental preservation and mitigating the adverse effects of excessive deforestation. To date, over 25,000 plants have been distributed through this initiative.

Furthermore, participants, referred to as MRites, engage in a green pledge alongside government school students to foster a sense of environmental responsibility and cultivate informed, nature-sensitive individuals. The Mega Plantation Drive is conducted annually in August, with plant donations tailored to meet the specific needs of participating villages and government schools. Annually, approximately 5,000 plants are planted at various community locations, including village panchayats and schools.

Objective

The primary objectives of this drive are:

- To distribute and plant various types of plants and trees in rural areas, government schools, and local community parks.
- To engage students and community members in environmental stewardship by nurturing informed, responsible, and nature-sensitive individuals.
- To fulfill the specific planting requirements of participating villages and schools, ensuring a tailored approach to reforestation efforts.

Impact

Since its inception, the Mega Plantation Drive has made a significant impact on the local environment and community awareness. Key impacts include:

- **Plant Distribution:** Over 25,000 plants have been distributed, enhancing green cover in various locations. The initiative focuses on indigenous plants that support local biodiversity and ecosystems.
- **Community Engagement:** By involving students from government schools in tree planting activities and green pledges, the drive fosters a sense of responsibility toward environmental conservation among young individuals.
- **Enhanced Green Spaces:** The development of green belts, particularly outside the newly developed Off Campus Hostel at Sector 45, Faridabad, contributes to urban biodiversity and improves the aesthetic value of community spaces.
- **Educational Outreach:** Workshops and discussions led by experts, such as Dr. NC Wadhwa, help raise awareness about the importance of trees and the role of individuals in preserving the environment.

Events

The Mega Plantation Drive has organized several impactful events, detailed below:

1. Annual Plant Distribution Drive (11 July - 12 July)

During this two-day event, indigenous plants were donated to the Save Aravali Trust and the Eco Club, Faridabad. These plants were subsequently planted across various locations in Faridabad, enhancing local green cover and supporting biodiversity.





2. Green Belt Development Drive (17 July)

On July 17, the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation organized a plantation drive to develop the Green Belt outside the newly developed Off Campus Hostel at Sector 45, Faridabad. This event saw enthusiastic participation from Foundation volunteers, volunteers from DSW-MRIIRS, and MRU students.

- **Key Highlights:**
 - Dr. NC Wadhwa addressed the students on the importance of tree plantation, emphasizing the role of trees in environmental sustainability.
 - Participants took a Green Oath, pledging to plant more trees and actively protect the environment.
 - The drive was supported by dignitaries, including the Dean of DSW-MRIIRS and the Deputy Director of MRIIRS, reinforcing the importance of community involvement in environmental initiatives.

Outcome

The Mega Plantation Drive has yielded several positive outcomes, demonstrating its effectiveness and the commitment of all stakeholders involved:

- **Increased Awareness:** Participants, including MRites and government school students, have become more aware of environmental issues and are actively participating in sustainability initiatives.
- **Sustainable Practices:** The planting of approximately 5,000 plants annually at community locations promotes sustainable practices and encourages ongoing environmental care.

- **Strengthened Community Bonds:** Collaborations among various organizations and institutions have strengthened community ties and fostered a shared vision of sustainability.
- **Long-term Environmental Benefits:** The initiative is expected to yield long-term benefits, including improved air quality, enhanced biodiversity, and a positive contribution to the local climate.

Give Her Wings to Fly

The 'Give Her Wings to Fly' initiative, led by the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation in collaboration with Manav Rachna University, is a holistic sensitization effort aimed at tackling the taboos surrounding menstruation among rural and underprivileged women. This initiative seeks to normalize discussions about menstrual hygiene within Indian households and promote personal hygiene among the female demographic. As part of our commitment to a healthier and more sustainable future, the initiative is aligned with our 'Green Planet' plantation drive. To date, we have successfully reached out to 5,000 individuals, distributing a total of 35,000 sanitary napkins to address menstrual health needs and promote environmental sustainability. Through these efforts, we strive to empower women and girls, ensuring they can manage their menstrual health with dignity and confidence.

Event I: Menstrual Awareness and Hygiene Drive under 'Give Her Wings to Fly' Initiative at Mohabbatabad Village

Date: 24th September

Location: Mohabbatabad Village

On 24th September, the 'Give Her Wings to Fly' initiative, organized by the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation in collaboration with student volunteers from Manav Rachna University, was conducted in Mohabbatabad Village. The primary aim of the initiative was to raise awareness about menstrual health and hygiene through engaging activities, including a Nukkad Naatak (street play). This event sought to educate the community, reduce the stigma surrounding menstruation, and ensure access to sanitary napkins, thereby contributing to improved health and well-being among women and girls in the area.

Objective:

The objective of this initiative was to promote menstrual awareness and hygiene among women and girls in Mohabbatabad Village. It aimed to educate the community about the importance of menstrual health, address prevalent myths and taboos, and ensure access to sanitary napkins for those in need. By breaking the silence surrounding menstruation, the initiative aimed to foster a more informed and accepting attitude towards this essential aspect of women's health.

Outcome:

The initiative successfully reached over 250 women and girls, providing them with sanitary napkins to support their menstrual hygiene management. This distribution increased the total number of sanitary napkins provided through the initiative to 27,000, reflecting a sustained effort in promoting women's health. Furthermore, the event created a more open environment for discussing menstrual health, encouraging women in the community to feel more comfortable addressing the subject.

Impact:

The impact of the initiative was significant, as the Nukkad Naatak effectively conveyed crucial information in an engaging manner, breaking down barriers to understanding menstrual hygiene. The collaboration with Satya Sai Foundation's Narayan Sewa drew a larger audience, creating a conducive atmosphere for learning. The involvement of student volunteers from Manav Rachna University proved valuable, enhancing outreach and cultivating a sense of community service among the youth. This initiative not only fostered a shift in attitudes towards menstrual health but also created a foundation for further health and educational interventions in the community.

The 'Give Her Wings to Fly' initiative exemplifies the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation's commitment to empowering women and girls by addressing critical social issues and ensuring access to essential resources for better health and well-being.





Event -II : Menstrual Hygiene Awareness and Sanitary Napkin Distribution Drive at Badhkal Flyover Slums by Dr. OP Bhalla Foundation

Location: Slums beneath the Badhkal Flyover, Faridabad

Objective:

The primary objective of the Menstrual Hygiene Awareness and Sanitary Napkin Distribution Drive was to promote menstrual hygiene among women and teenage girls living in the slums beneath the Badhkal Flyover. The initiative aimed to raise awareness about menstrual health, educate the community about hygienic practices during menstruation, and dispel common myths associated with menstruation, including information on Polycystic Ovarian Disease (PCOD). By distributing sanitary napkins, the drive sought to empower women and girls to manage their menstrual health with dignity and confidence.

Impact:

The drive had a significant impact on the local community. Through the efforts of the student volunteers, awareness was raised about the importance of menstrual hygiene, leading to increased understanding of healthy practices during menstruation. The information shared regarding PCOD and other menstrual health issues was crucial in educating women and girls about their bodies, promoting a more informed perspective. The active participation of first-year students from

Manav Rachna University enhanced the outreach of the initiative, showcasing a strong commitment to community service and social responsibility.

Outcome:

A total of 900 sanitary napkins were distributed to women and teenage girls residing in the area, providing them with essential resources for menstrual management. The distribution not only addressed immediate hygiene needs but also fostered a sense of empowerment among the recipients. The engagement of numerous first-year students from the MR campus was remarkable, as they became integral participants in this impactful endeavor, reinforcing the idea of youth involvement in social issues. Overall, the drive successfully contributed to normalizing conversations around menstruation and improved the community's awareness of menstrual health, paving the way for future initiatives aimed at enhancing women's health and hygiene.

This drive by the Dr. OP Bhalla Foundation exemplifies a commitment to uplifting underprivileged communities and fostering a more inclusive society where menstrual health is openly discussed and prioritized.



Mammography Screening Camp

Report on the Complimentary Mammography Screening Camp in Mohabbatabad Village

Date: April 26, 2024

Organized by: Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation, in association with Manav Rachna University

Objective: To promote early breast cancer detection in Mohabbatabad village, engaging Manav Rachna University students in community health outreach and awareness.

On April 26, 2024, the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation, in collaboration with Manav Rachna University, organized a complimentary mammography screening camp in the village of Mohabbatabad. This initiative aimed to promote early detection of breast cancer among women aged 40 and older, addressing a critical health need in rural areas. The camp sought to raise awareness about the importance of regular screenings, provide free access to mammography tests, and educate the community on breast health and cancer prevention.

The camp saw the participation of 21 women from the local area, all aged 40 and above, who received complimentary mammography screenings. By organizing this event, the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation and Manav Rachna University highlighted the necessity of early detection in combating breast cancer and encouraged the participants to prioritize preventive health measures. The screening tests conducted at the camp provided early indicators of potential health concerns, allowing women to pursue timely medical follow-up if necessary. Additionally, the camp helped foster a broader understanding of proactive healthcare in the community, underscoring the importance of regular health check-ups.

Overall, the camp successfully fulfilled its objectives by providing accessible screening and empowering participants with essential knowledge on breast health. Each participant was given the results of their screenings, along with recommendations for any further action if needed. Through this event, the Dr. O P Bhalla Foundation and Manav Rachna University reaffirmed their dedication to promoting community health and cancer awareness, paving the way for future health initiatives aimed at enhancing women's health and well-being in the region.

Impact: The camp raised breast cancer awareness among 21 local women and provided Manav Rachna University students with valuable community health experience.

Outcome: All participants received free screenings and guidance, reinforcing early detection practices and enhancing student involvement in public health.



Ek Mutthi Daan

Report on "No One Sleeps Hungry – A Movement: Ek Mutthi Daan Initiative"

Objective

The **Ek Mutthi Daan** initiative, launched on March 28, 2014, under the **No One Sleeps Hungry** movement, aims to address the pressing issue of hunger and food insecurity among the most vulnerable segments of society. Inspired by the life and philosophy of Dr. O P Bhalla, the Founder Chancellor of Manav Rachna University, this campaign encourages individuals to donate a modest quantity of dry grains, fostering a sense of social responsibility and community engagement. The initiative happens **twice a year** at **Manav Rachna University**, with **all students actively participating in both drives** to maximize its impact. The campaign collaborates with various NGOs, including Earth Saviors Foundation and SHEOWS, to ensure that the collected food reaches those in dire need.

Donation (2023-24)

In the 2023-24 session, Manav Rachna University students contributed 2,000 kg of daal, 4,000 kg of rice, and 1,000 kg of wheat under the "Ek Mutthi Daan" initiative. These donations aimed to support community nourishment and improve food security for those in need.

Impact

Since its inception, the **Ek Mutthi Daan** campaign has had a profound impact on the community and has mobilized a collective effort towards alleviating hunger. Key impacts include:

- **Food Distribution:** Approximately **117,000 kgs** of dry grains, including pulses, rice, and wheat, have been collected and distributed to various needy organizations and individuals.
- **Community Engagement:** The campaign has united the Manav Rachna University family, with all students, faculty, and staff coming together to support the cause. This unity fosters a culture of giving and social awareness among the youth, encouraging them to participate actively in community welfare.

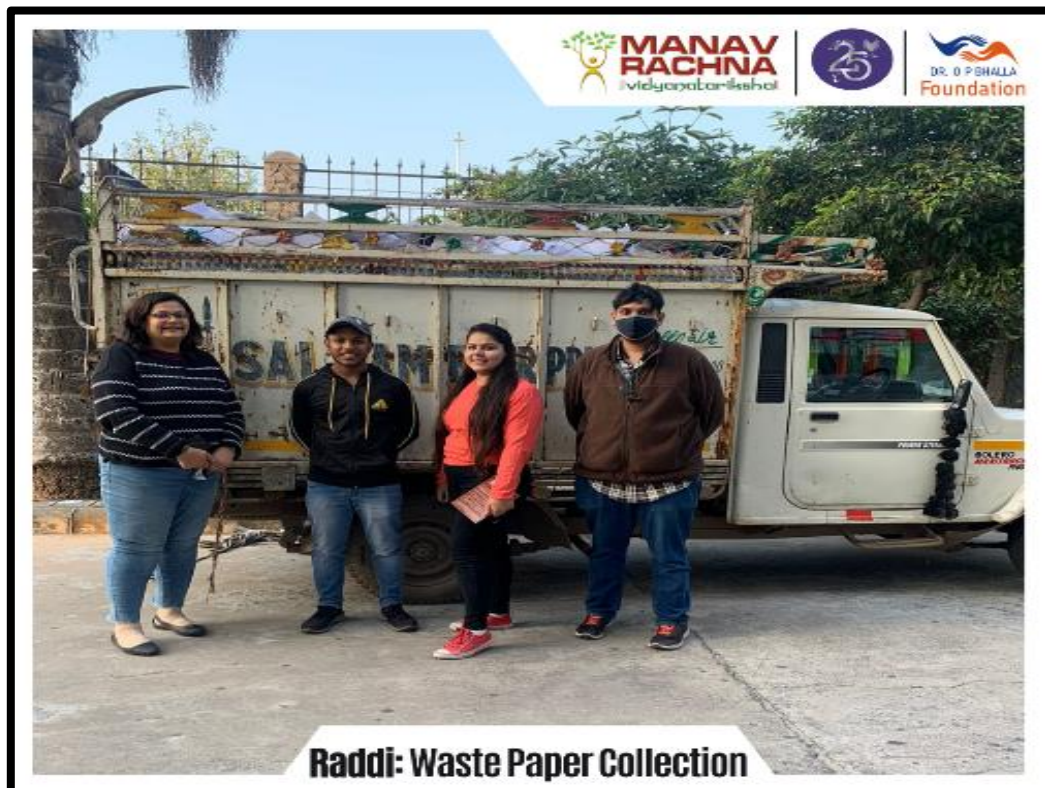

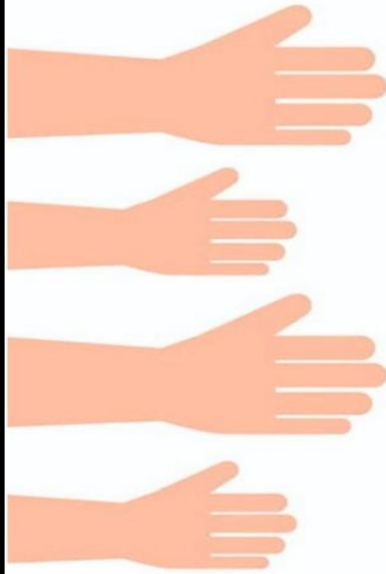
